

COLORS USED:

BLUE PURPLE BROWN + Dot of BLACK WHITE SHIMMER WHITE (Small Drop)

Background: **PURPLE BRUSH:** Paint BLUE on the right side of the canvas starting 1 ½-2" from the top to 6" in (1" from center), and angling down to about 3" from left edge of canvas. Paint PURPLE across the top of the canvas and fill in the left side. Paint PURPLE over the BLUE edge to blend. Streak PURPLE/ BLUE over each other. Rinse brush. Dip only the tip of the brush in WHITE paint. Paint streaks throughout the background



holding your brush the thin way. When most of the paint is off the brush, turn your brush the wide way and blend in WHITE streaks. Add more as needed but don't over lighten.

Dry Break

HORIZON: BLUE BRUSH: Dip the brush in BLACK paint. Hold the brush the thin way. Paint a line 3-4" up from the bottom of the canvas. Paint a rolling hill above the line that goes from 1 ½" on both sides to ¼" near the center. The thinnest point is off center to the left. Fill the strip in.

TREES: **GREEN BRUSH** or **BLUE BRUSH**: Holding the brush the thin way, dip in BROWN paint. Paint a tree stump a little over an inch in from the left side, ½ way up the canvas. Paint a long, thin branch angling to the right that reaches into the BLUE side. Paint another thin branch straight up from truck and one that angles to the left and off the canvas. Build up your trunk so it is wider at the bottom. Paint another tree 3" in from right side that is 4" tall, then continue angling to the left, making a branch that sits just below the branch from the left tree and goes onto the PURPLE side. Starting at the horizon, add 3 more branches off this curved tree. The first branch angles to the right and off the canvas, the second 2 branches point up and to the left. Build up the base of the tree a bit. Add small branches that curve towards the main branches, as many as you want to fill the space. Paint 2 small saplings to the right of each of the large trees. Add small branches to the saplings.

Leaves: **BLUE BRUSH:** Starting with the tree and saplings on the left -- Dip in BLUE and WHITE paint. Place your brush flat on the canvas with one end on a branch and push out and lift up at the same time to create leaves. Paint as many leaves as you want on the tree. Make the leaves smaller for the saplings. For the tree and saplings on the right -- Dip in PURPLE and WHITE paint. Repeat the process.

Moon: **BLUE BRUSH:** Dip in SHIMMER WHITE. Paint a small circle (little smaller than a quarter) on the left center of canvas or where ever you need a little shine. Hold the brush the thin way and paint little jagged strokes in a rough diamond or oval shape in the "water" below the horizon. Don't forget to sign your artwork! ^(C)
